Proficient use of the English language is mandatory. The successful candidate will guide the psychometric development of a new QOL instrument in children and adults and reinforce our analyses and writing team concerning results of the EU-Center-TBI study on outcome.

Proficiency in English (publications and international cooperation) and German is vital, as the position may require teaching at the University Medicine Göttingen and cooperation in national and international research consortia.
