## Post-doctoral Researcher (100%; TV-L) for a period of 3 years.

The position is funded by the German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft; DFG) in the project *Sociomotor Action Control*. The planned research targets action representation and control in social interactions using behavioral and electrophysiological (EEG, EMG) data.

The position involves planning, programming and running experimental studies, and communicating findings at international conferences as well as in peer-reviewed journals. As an ideal candidate, you would have a PhD in Psychology, Systems Neuroscience, Cognitive Science, or a related field. Programming skills (e.g., E-Prime, PsychoPy) and analysis skills (e.g., SPSS, R, MATLAB) are essential, experience with electrophysiological data is a plus.

The Department of Cognitive Psychology offers a vibrant working environment and a supportive and stimulating group. The University of Würzburg is an equal opportunity employer and aims to increase the proportion of women in science; researchers (m/f/d) with children are especially encouraged to apply. Persons with disabilities will be considered preferentially in the case of equal aptitude.

The application deadline is February 9, 2021. The start of the position can be negotiated, with an earliest starting date in April 2021.
