The successful applicants are expected to assist in production management and are primarily responsible for the production (copy- and layout editing) of full issues of PsychOpen GOLD scientific journals. PsychOpen GOLD is ZPID's open access publication platform for psychology.

You will work in close collaboration with the team of PsychOpen GOLD within Archiving and Publication Services. Production management will be accompanied by formal quality checks of manuscripts, distribution of final articles and metadata to indexing services, as well as communication with authors and editors. You will also support the team in optimizing and evolving production workflows and -processes.
